Unit of Study:

We will be going over positional words and opposites. We will be making a list of words that rhyme with the word "icky", such as "sticky" and "picky".

Shape: Circle **Number:** 14 – Fourteen

Color: Red. We will be looking at items that are red in color. We will look in nature, in books, foods we eat, as well as the clothes we wear. I encourage the children to continue this activity at home, discovering items in their life that are the color red.
