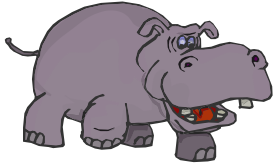

- You and your child can act out different zoo animal sounds together!

- Read 1 Samuel 1:1-20. This is a Bible story of a man named Elkanah who was married to a woman named Hannah. Hannah was unable to have a child so she and Elkanah went to the temple to pray. Eli, a priest at the temple, asked Hannah what she was doing at the temple. She replied that she was asking God to give her a child. Eli told her to go in peace and her prayer would be answered. Hannah told God that if He gave her a son, she would give the child back to Him, and that his hair would never be cut. Hannah did conceive and had a son whom she named Samuel.
