Home Enrichment Activities:

- Engage your child in pretend play by being turkeys together. Ask your child what sound a turkey makes. Talk like a turkey. Ask your child how they think turkeys walk. Walk like a turkey! Dress up in feathers to get the full turkey experience. ☺ Ask your child what they think turkeys eat. Eat some corn for a yummy turkey snack.
- Teach your child to play "Thankful Football": Say something you are thankful for; then toss a football to your child and it's his/her turn to say something he/she is thankful for. The next person that they throw the ball to says what they're thankful for and so on. You can play with family and/or friends!
- Practice weight concepts by holding a heavy object, then a light object in each hand and ask, "Which object is heavier? Which one feels lighter?"
- Discuss this week's Bible Story of Queen Esther. Use construction paper to make a crown with your child.
