Unit of Study:

The Senses – Sight, Hearing, Taste, Smell & Touch

Week's Work:

Students will discuss the senses and how they help our body work. We will learn the proper printing and long sound for the letter "Ee". We will work on our "zoo animal" signs, finger spelling our names and counting 1 - 15 in ASL. Also, we will be discussing where we live: the state, city, & street name. We will continue to work on counting numbers 1 - 30.

Phonics:

Easton Eagle E says, "e – e, e, e" as in eat, eel, Eli, Easter, & Egypt (long e sound).

Rhyming:

We will be making a list of words that rhyme with the word "eel", such as "teal" and "zeal".

Share Day:

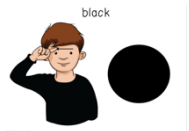
This week your child may bring something about the senses or something that is the color black.

Weekly Academic Practice:

Shape: Diamond

Number: Seven

Color: Black - We will be looking at items that are black in color. We will look in nature, in books, foods we eat, as well as the clothes we wear. I encourage the children to continue this activity at home, discovering items in their life that are the color black. During the week, if a student wears an article of clothing that is black, they will receive a special sticker.

Enrichment Activities:

- *Find different items in your house that start with the long "Ee" sound.
- *Practice signing manner signs and our color signs.
