*Talk about St. Patrick's Day, with your child. This holiday is celebrated on March 17th every year to commemorate St. Patrick bringing Christianity to Ireland. Patrick used the shamrock to explain the Trinity to the people of Ireland. Showing the 3-leafed clover to them, he explained that God the Father, the Son, and Holy Spirit are three persons, yet one God. People around the world like to "be Irish for a day" on this holiday, by wearing shamrocks, having "green" parties, and eating corned beef and cabbage.

*Read and discuss the Bible Story: "Jesus Walks on the Water" (Matt. 14:25-33). Shortly before dawn Jesus went out to them, walking on the lake. When the disciples saw him walking on the lake, they were terrified. "It's a ghost," they said, and cried out in fear. But Jesus immediately said to them: "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid." "Lord, if it's you," Peter replied, "tell me to come to you on the water." "Come," he said. Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus. ³But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink cried out, "Lord, save me!" Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?" And when they climbed into the boat, the wind died down. Then those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."
