



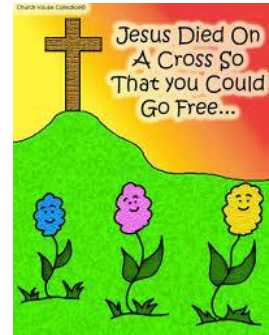

Home Enrichment Activities:

- Create a bird feeder with your child! Spread peanut butter on a pine cone and roll it in bird seed. Hang it somewhere outside where it will be easy to spot birds as they eat their snack!
- Make binoculars with your child! Cut an empty paper towel roll in half and have your child decorate the tubes with any art supplies you have in the house. Then, glue the tubes together and let them dry. After your binoculars are dry, go to the park to go bird watching! Or just sit outside and look for birds flying around your neighborhood. Count how many birds you can spot.
- Take a trip to El Dorado Park and watch the ducks play and interact with each other.
- Read Matthew 6:26 and discuss how much God loves us and watches over us, like He does the birds. "Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap, or store in barns, and yet your Heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they?" Have a five-minute Bible devotion on the verses Matthew 6:25-33 with your family. What is Jesus saying about worrying about things? What does God want us to do instead?
