- Collect some items from your recycle bin that can be safely used to make something new. Brainstorm with your child: what can you make with these things that would be otherwise considered "trash"? Remind them that recycling is one way we can keep our earth clean.
- Read "The Lorax" by Dr. Seuss with your child. Have a discussion about how we can take care of the earth.
