Unit of Study: St. Patrick's Day

Home Enrichment Activities:

- Go on a "green" scavenger hunt with your child. Make a list of things to find (for example: something soft, something you eat, something you can wear) and hunt for green things that match those descriptions!
- Have a special St. Patrick's Day rainbow snack! Choose something "rainbow", such as fruits of various colors, "Froot Loops" cereal, or mini M&M's. Start by washing your hands and your child's hands. Then, sort the special rainbow snack items by color. After you are done, eat one of each color!
- Help your child practice printing our letter, U, and numbers 1 - 20, using a green crayon or marker.
- Make a "palm branch" craft with your child as you talk about this week's Bible story together! Help your child trace their hand on a green piece of paper. You will need 4 – 6 handprints total. Then, assist your child as they cut out their handprints. Next, glue the handprints to a popsicle stick, leaving room for a handle. While the glue is drying, read the story of Jesus' triumphal entry in Matthew 21:1–11. After the glue is dry, ask your child to wave their "palm branch" and say, "Hosannah! Blessed is the One who comes in the name of the Lord!"
